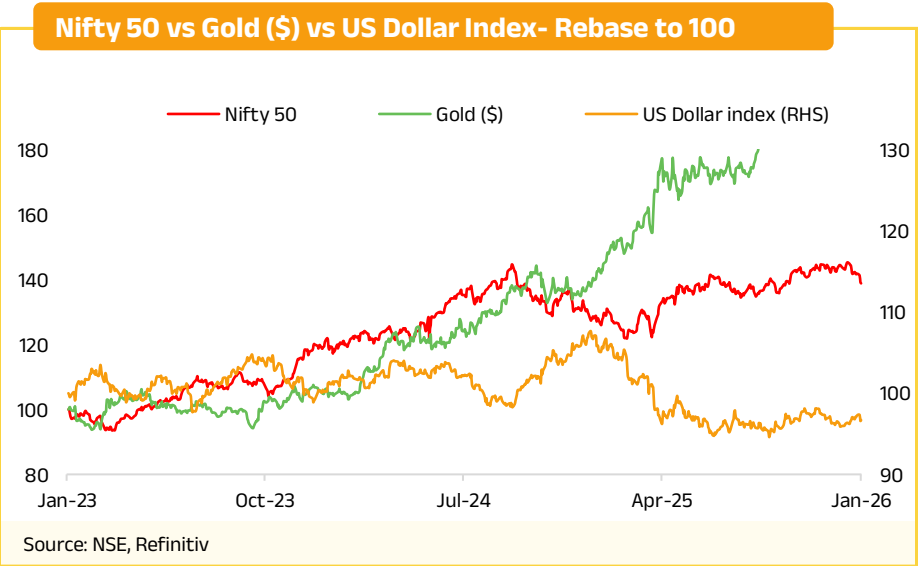
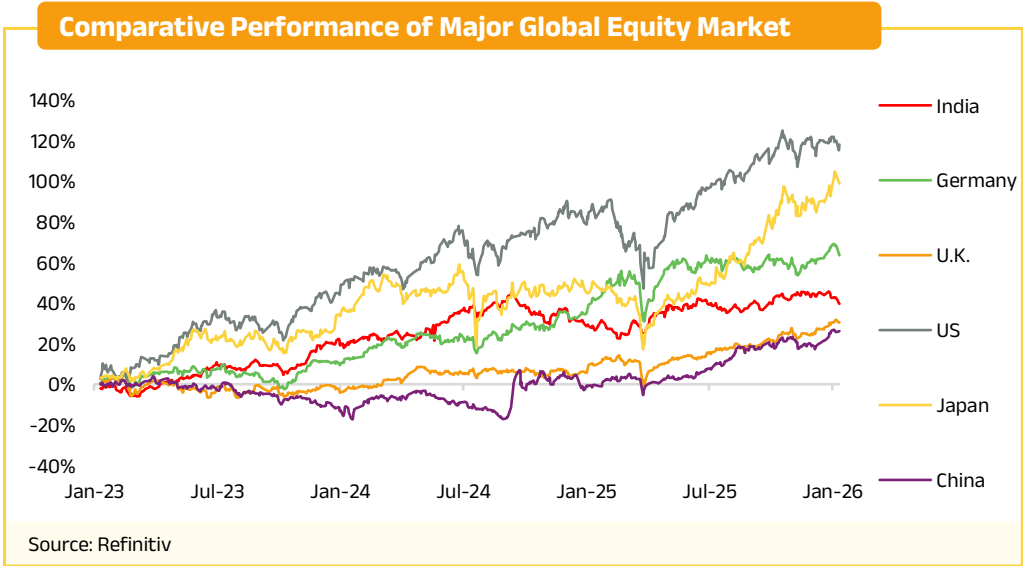

Equity as a Source of Finance

Definition: Equity as a source of finance refers to the funds raised by a company through the issue of equity shares to investors. Equity shareholders are the owners of the company and share in its profits as well as risks. Unlike debt, equity capital does not require fixed interest payments or compulsory repayment.



Explanation

Equity is an important source of long-term finance for businesses, especially for new ventures and expanding companies. Since equity capital does not involve interest obligations, it reduces the financial burden on firms during periods of low profits. This flexibility allows companies to invest in expansion, research and development, and long-term projects.

Equity financing improves the financial stability and risk-bearing capacity of a firm, as losses are shared by shareholders. It also strengthens the capital base of the company and enhances its creditworthiness, making it easier to raise additional funds in the future.
