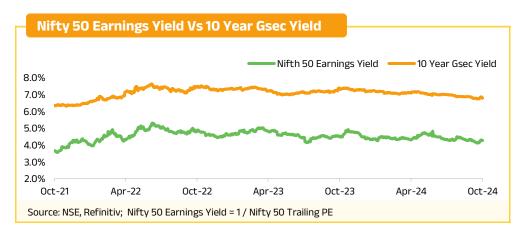


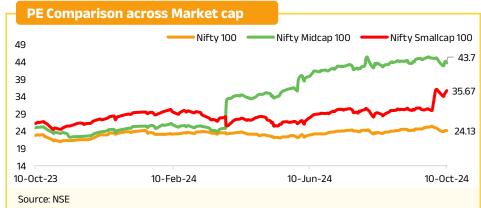
Indian equity markets witnessed a range-bound trading session and closed on a flat note with minor gains. Banking sector rose the most, while information & technology and pharma sector witnessed selling pressure. Investors awaited for key U.S. inflation print of Sep 2024 for further cues.

Suzlon announced that it has secured a 400-megawatt (Mw) contract from JSP Green Wind 1, a subsidiary of Jindal Renewables, aimed at reducing carbon emissions in steel manufacturing. This initiative represents the largest commercial and industrial wind energy contract in India.

Adani Group plans to develop 10 gigawatts of hydroelectric projects internationally as part of its strategy to attain net zero carbon emissions by the year 2050. This initiative encompasses projects in countries such as Nepal, Bhutan, Kenya, Tanzania, the Philippines, and Vietnam. Additionally, the group aspires to achieve a renewable energy capacity of 50 gigawatts by 2030.

Zydus Lifesciences Ltd announced that it has obtained final approval from the US health authority to produce its generic version of Paliperidone extended-release tablets, which are used for treating schizophrenia. The US Food and Drug Administration (USFDA) has approved the tablets in strengths of 1.5 mg, 3 mg, 6 mg, and 9 mg.

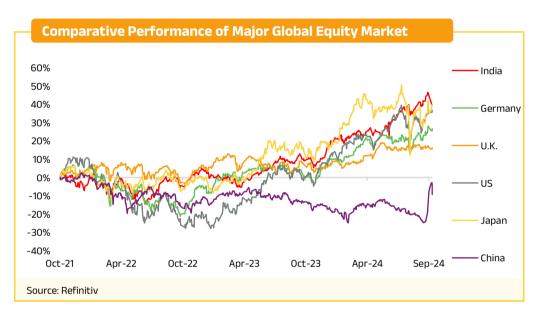


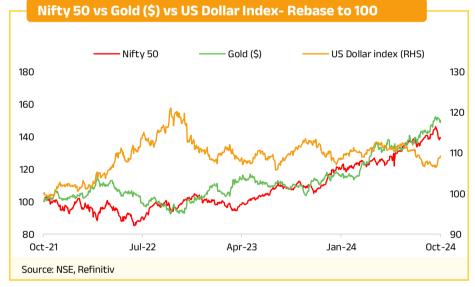

Value and Growth Fund

Definition: Growth and value are the two most common investment strategies. These two styles of investment have different set of characteristics that make either, or both suitable for investors based on the investment objective of the investor. During different economic conditions, either of these strategies can dominate.



Explanation

A basic principal behind value investing is that markets are inefficient and investors can benefit from this anomaly. In other words, value investing is about finding stocks that the market has not correctly priced. It involves buying a stock on the basis of its fundamentals which include earning growth, cash flow, dividend yield, book value and replacement cost. If the **company's** fundamentals are strong but the **stock's** price is below its obvious value, then there arises a value investing opportunity. On the other hand, growth investing targets stocks which have above average earning growth rate, above average sales growth rate and low dividend yield.
