Indian equity markets closed with substantial increases led by oil & gas stocks and PSU banks. The surge in the market was also driven by fresh foreign fund inflows. Additionally, the market saw a rise due to optimism stemming from positive forecasts for the upcoming Union Budget, along with robust Q1FY25 earnings reported by Indian companies.

HDFC Life announced a 15% increase in its standalone net profit to Rs 477 crore for the first quarter of 2024, as opposed to Rs 415 crore in the corresponding period last year. Net premium income during the Apr-Jun 2024 period increased 9% YoY to Rs 12,510 crore. It was Rs 11,480 crore in the corresponding period of the previous year.

Bank of Maharashtra (BoM), a government-owned bank, announced a 46.6% rise in its net profit to Rs 1,293 crore for the quarter ending in Jun 2024. The Puneheadquartered bank recorded a net profit of Rs 882 crore in the same period last year. During the quarter, the bank's total income increased to Rs 6,769 crore, up from Rs 5,417 crore a year ago.

Indian Renewable Energy Development Agency (IREDA) announced a net profit of Rs 384 crore for the quarter ended Jun 30, 2024, marking a 30% increase from the Rs 295 crore reported in the same period last year. The revenue from operations stood at Rs 1.502 crore in the quarter against Rs 1,144 crore logged in the corresponding quarter of the previous financial year.

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




Private Equity Fund

Definition: It is a closed-end fund, which raises funds from institutional investors, high net worth individuals corporate, pension funds, and invests in private companies or publicly traded companies. Simply put, it is a collective investment scheme (CIS). In private equity (PE) fund, normally, investors who bring most of the capital and pay management fee are called limited partners and the fund managers are known as general partners.



Explanation

The typical life of the PE fund is 10 years and can be extended for up to three additional years. PE firms can of various types, depending upon the stage of the company the fund invests and methods used to financing. Accordingly, there are four types of PE fund: Venture capital (VC), Growth equity, Leveraged buyout and Distressed or turnaround situations.
